

Bible Bookmarks

What are Bible Bookmarks?

The Bible Bookmarks program is a wonderful way to help your child get in the habit of being in the Word each day. The bookmarks are put out weekly for the children to pick up. The bookmarks have verses for the children to look up and read each day, Monday-Saturday. You don't have to write the answer on the bookmark, but just initial that your child read it. The bookmarks need to be turned in each Sunday to one of our 5th grade helpers with their **FIRST and LAST name** written on the bookmark. They will not get credit if they don't have their name on their bookmark. Once they turn in their bookmark, they will receive 5 Bible Bucks. We will keep a log of all the bookmarks that are turned in each week.

Rewards

Once each quarter is completed we will have a Bible Bookmark recognition for the children who have read all of their bookmarks for the quarter. They will receive a certificate and a \$5.00 gift card to Diddy's Yogurt Shoppe. Also, at the end of one completed year (January-December), we recognize the children who have read their bookmark for the entire year. They will also get a PT Kids t-shirt and they will be introduced to the congregation for their achievement.

Where do we get the bookmarks?

Bookmarks will be available at the check-in table in the foyer of the auditorium. There will also be some available in Jump Street in a basket.

Parents:

Please be aware of your child's activity with these bookmarks. Ask questions about what they are reading. Maybe spend your quiet time with them reading these verses together before bed or at the dinner table or at breakfast. You don't have to write the answer on the bookmark, just discuss it and initial. This is an honor system, yet it also is an opportunity to get into the Word each day with your child.

If your child reads their bible every day and writes down what they read and turns it in...we will honor that too. As long as they are in the WORD! ☺
