

## ***Bible Bucks***

### **What is it?**

Bible Bucks is a reward system used to encourage and promote Bible reading, Bible facts, scripture memorization, outreach, generosity, kindness, and service to others.

### **How will it work?**

As the children come into Jump Street, they go to the “Bank” to “earn” their Bible Bucks. Teachers can also award bucks based on specific acts accomplished (knowing all the books of the Bible, etc...). The “Bank” will be located in the entrance hall of Jump Street and is open 10 minutes before class begins as they come in for Large group.

### **How do the children earn Bible Bucks?**

The children will receive Bible Bucks for bringing their Bible, bringing a visitor, knowing their memory verse (once per month), completing Worship Notes (on the check-in table in the foyer of the auditorium) and completing a weekly Bible Bookmark.

### **How will they SAVE their bucks?**

The children will keep up with their own bucks in an envelope we provide. We will have a box located in the BANK where all the envelopes will be stored that our 5<sup>th</sup> graders will help keep organized.

### **How would they SPEND their bucks?**

The Market will be open on the last Sunday of the month for the children to purchase items after Bible class. The items range from small trinkets, such as pencils, bracelets, etc... to larger priced items like games, balls, and Nerf guns.

### **How will they GIVE their bucks?**

The children will have the option each month to purchase items that will benefit others. (Christmas market, school supplies for Honduras school, toiletries for Caring and Sharing)

### **Where and when will the market be open?**

The Market will be located in Jump Street. The Market will be open on the last Sunday of each month immediately following Bible classes from 11:15-11:30ish.

### **Who will work the Market?**

We are always looking for VOLUNTEERS. Commitment time would be the last Sunday of each month during and after bible class. We need MALE and FEMALE volunteers that will encourage and be excited for the children. Our 5<sup>th</sup> graders will also be helpers in the Market too.
